## SCHOOL MEAL PRICE INCREASE

Please note that from Tuesday 5 September 2017 there will be a price increase to the school lunch. Meals will cost £1.90 per day a total of £9.50 for the week.

Parkside Primary Academy's School Meals Debt Policy and Procedure states that: Parents/Carers must pay in advance for the school meal. Children will not be provided with a school meal unless it is paid for. If the parent genuinely forgets to pay in advance, the school may grant a debt allowance of 1 meal.

If the debt is not cleared, parents must provide a packed lunch. In a case when debt payment is not received nor a packed lunch provided, the administration office will phone the parent to ask them to either come into school with the money.

If debts are incurred, then it is school that has to find a way to pay for them. This means that money which should be spent on children's education is used to pay for debts incurred by parents.
