




PARKSIDE PRIMARY ACADEMY HOME/SCHOOL AGREEMENT

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an environment which has been Risk Assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection by the Academy Trust, Academy Governors and ProAktive, our health and safety partners. • Provide training for all staff to support the reopening of school, following the guidance outlined in the Risk Assessment • Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can • Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child’s well-being, mental health and academic needs; • Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19 • Take swift action and inform parents/carers if we are made aware that a member of staff or pupil in your child’s ‘phased pod’ has tested positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days and get tested. School will also contact the local health protection team and follow their guidance • Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement • Communicate between home and school through texts, email and the school website. • Adhere to the Hierarchy of Measures which are set out in the Risk Assessment • Provide children with First Aid and intimate care (where absolutely necessary) following guidance around the use of PPE • Support children to administer medication independently e.g. asthma inhalers • Support children to be independent with intimate care needs such as toileting • Ensure all SEND children have an updated Risk Assessment in line with government guidance • Update its behaviour policy to include COVID -19 expectations • Work with children to follow new school systems and structures • Provide a packed lunch meal for those children entitled to a Free School Meal – this includes KS2 children entitled to a Free School Meal and also all F2 and KS1 children entitled to an infant universal Free School Meal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will refer to government guidelines to assess if my child is classed as extremely vulnerable or vulnerable to ascertain if they can return to school. • I will read the Academy Risk Assessment and adhere to the hierarchy of measures outlined in the Risk Assessment • If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone. • If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible via telephone or email. • On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to keep left system, observe floor markings and social distancing rules. • When dropping off and picking my child up, only one adult will come on to the school site to do this. If I have to bring other children with me, I will make sure they adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and will be under my full control and supervision all the time. • When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the ‘Phased Pod’ timings and specific locations for my child/ren. • I will adhere to social distancing and understand I should only come to the school office reception area if my query cannot be dealt with on the telephone/by email/through the intercom. I understand that only one family at a time is allowed in the reception area. • All meetings in school should be via prior appointment. I will communicate via telephone and email. • I will support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this time. • I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home. • I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details. • I will send my child with a packed lunch or order one from school. My child will have a labelled water bottle • I will not expect school to administer medication (unless absolutely necessary in which case a Care Plan is required) • I will not expect the school to undertake any intimate care in regards of toileting (unless absolutely necessary) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow the Phased Pod rules that keep me safe. This will be at all times including break and lunchtimes • Wash/sanitise my hands as soon as I go into school. • Tell an adult if I feel unwell. • Follow the arrows in the school grounds • Line up where my class sign is • Not mix with any other children in the school, other than those in my Phased Pod • Stay next to my parent/carers when they pick me up/drop me off • Follow the rules when I am removing a face covering – I will not touch the front of my face when I am using it or I take it off; if it is a temporary face mask I will put it in a lidded bin as soon as I come into school, if it is reusable I will put it in a plastic bag ready to take home • Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue. • Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds. • Follow the rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others. • Follow these expectations and know that if I don’t I will receive consequences through the school behaviour system
