



**Behaviour Management Policy
Addendum 1 – Covid-19
(to be read in accordance with the existing behaviour management
policy)**

Aim

The ultimate aim of this policy is to promote the safeguarding of children as defined by the Pioneer Community Academy Trust statement on safeguarding children

Rationale

Parkside Primary Academy recognises that these are challenging times for everyone, children and staff, however we must all follow the legislative guidance given in order to keep children and staff safe.

Academy Expectations

- ✓ All children to use the designated entrances and exits for their class
- ✓ Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds using the picture instructions
- ✓ Respect each other's space – follow the social distancing rules
- ✓ Only use the toilets designated for your class
- ✓ Follow the 'one person at a time' signs in cloakrooms and toilets
- ✓ When coughing, sneezing, blowing your nose follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' rules and dispose of any used tissues immediately in a lidded bin.
- ✓ Tell an adult immediately if you don't feel well
- ✓ Do not cough or spit at or towards anyone
- ✓ Do not share equipment

If children choose not to follow these Academy expectations and behave inappropriately they will not be allowed to return to school until they can keep themselves and others safe.
