

## Parental Information about Learning Support and Feedback

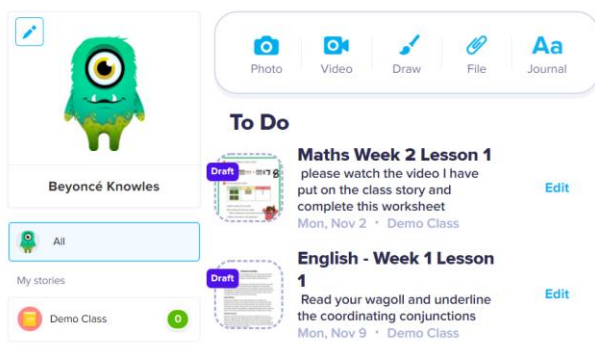

### What does teacher/child feedback look like?

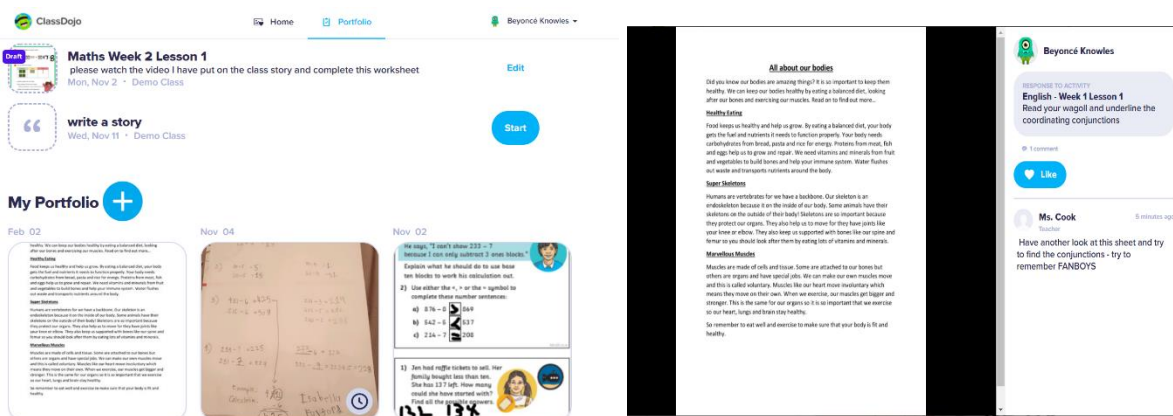
When a child hands in a piece of work, their teacher will either:

- Like and approve (this means that everything is good)
- Comment and approve (this means that the piece of work is exceptional or that you may be asked to check or correct something for next time)
- Comment and return as a draft (this means that the work needs to be looked at again)

We are aware that you are not notified when we add a comment. If you see your child's work return to their portfolio as a draft – please click edit and check any comments for support



If the work has been approved, you can check for comments if you click on the work.



### When will we get feedback?

Staff will strive to respond to children's work within at least 24 hours from when it is submitted. We do understand many adults are still working so you may be sending your children's work in after 5.30pm which is perfectly ok; this means that teachers will aim to respond to it the next working day. Teachers will be available for learning support and feedback between 8am and 5.00pm on working days.
